RE: Recovery of Costs from Agencies with Assistant Attorneys General That Receive Central OAG Support

Attached are two invoices from the Office of the Attorney General: one for the OAG Compliance Division in Baltimore in the amount of \$12,380.00, and the other for our division in the amount of \$9,904.00. The expenses are to recover costs from the agencies with assistant attorneys general that receive central OAG support.

You can calculate these figures by multiplying \$2,476 per person in each division.

OAG - Compliance Division: $5 \times \$2,476 = \$12,380.00$

OAG - Comptroller Division: $4 \times \$2,476 = \$9,904.00$

As you are aware, John Barry's time is shared between our office and Md. Supplemental Retirement Plans at the rate of 2/3rds and 1/3rd, respectively. I believe this expense should also

be share at the same rate. Therefore, would you kindly bill MSRP 1/3rd of John's expense for a total of \$825.33?
