Overall Summary & Analysis

U.S. Senate Contest

Among likely 2016 Republican primary voters, 23% have a favorable opinion of Barry Glassman (10% “very favorable” and 13% “somewhat favorable”), while only 2% have an unfavorable opinion of Glassman (1% “very unfavorable” and 1% “somewhat unfavorable”), 18% are neutral, and 57% don’t recognize his name.

The results by region:

In Harford County, 83% have a favorable opinion of Glassman, and 96% approve of the job he is doing as County Executive.

Statewide, 7% have a favorable opinion of Kathy Szeliga (3% “very favorable” and 4% “somewhat favorable”), while 3% have an unfavorable opinion of Szeliga (2% “very unfavorable” and 1% “somewhat unfavorable”), 9% are neutral, and 82% don’t recognize her name.

Five percent have a favorable opinion of Richard Douglas (3% “very favorable” and 2% “somewhat favorable”), while 1% have an unfavorable opinion of Douglas, 13% are neutral, and 81% don’t recognize his name.

Four percent have a favorable opinion of Chrys Kefalas, 1% has an unfavorable opinion of Kefalas, 13% are neutral, and 87% don’t recognize his name.

Four percent have a favorable opinion of Anthony Seda, 1% has an unfavorable opinion of Seda, 6% are neutral, and 90% don’t recognize his name.

In an election match-up, Glassman leads with 19%, Szeliga gets 11%, Douglas has 5%, Kefalas has 2%, Seda has 1%, and 62% are undecided.

Governor Larry Hogan

Among likely 2016 Republican primary voters, an overwhelming 91% approve of the job Larry Hogan is doing as governor (71% “strongly approve” and 20% “somewhat approve”), while only 1% disapprove, with 8% offering no response.

Common Core

Nineteen percent support the Common Core approach to public education in Maryland (3% “strongly support” and 16% “somewhat support”), while 69% oppose the Common Core approach to public education (55% “strongly oppose” and 14% “somewhat oppose”), with 12% offering no response.

Methodology

This poll was commissioned by *Friends of Barry Glassman* in order to assess the attitudes and opinions of voters on a range of issues related to the April, 2016 Republican primary election for U.S. Senate.

A total of 302 registered Republicans in Maryland who are likely to vote in next year's primary were interviewed by telephone between October 20th and October 28th, 2015. Respondents were selected at random and interviews were balanced throughout the state to reflect GOP primary voting patterns.

The margin of error, according to customary statistical standards, is no more than plus or minus 5.75 percentage points for the entire sample. This means that at a 95 percent confidence level the "true" figures would fall within this range if the total survey universe were sampled. The margin is higher for any demographic subgroup of the sample, such as age or gender.
